Evacuation and Lockdown Drills

Over the coming weeks, we will be refining our Emergency procedures. As a minimum, we are required to have an evacuation drill every 6 months. In addition, we need to have Lockdown and Bush Fire drills. As part of these procedures, the gate opposite the Police Station will be locked between 9:00am and 3:00pm. The gate near the Administration building will remain unlocked during school hours.

Some children can become distressed when we have drills. Please speak to your children about the need for us to practise our procedures, so that we all know what we would do in case of a real emergency.

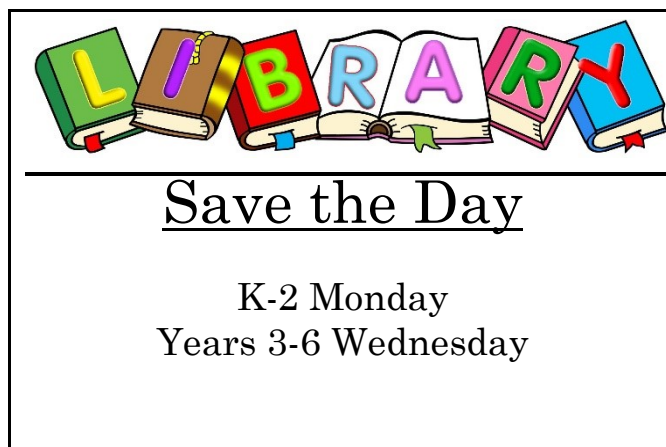

We continue with the Recycle Program, the kids collect items and use them for Creative arts.

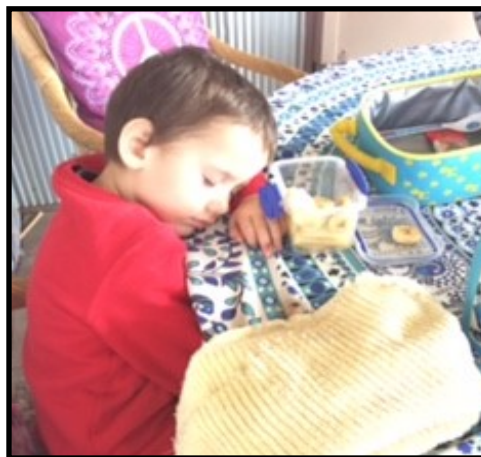
With this awesome weather we are experiencing, there's been plenty of outdoor time in the nature area exploring the environment. We were very happy to finally see water in the rain

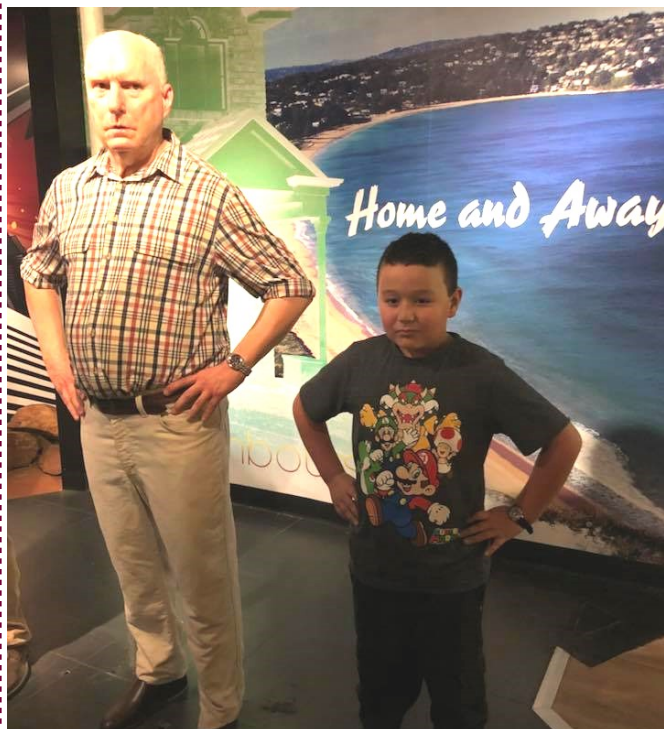
